The FRCE partnership with the FDNY builds on their previous relationship with the New York City Fire Department which began with support of the FDNY publication – "Reduce York Risk" and production of several cancer related videos beginning in 2017.

As part of this recent partnership, the FRCE has sponsored a series of 6 short training videos produced by the FDNY Bureau of Training. The goal of these videos is to further educate firefighters of simple actions they can take to reduce their risk of occupational cancer. "This series of videos is designed to bring a greater awareness and mindfulness of simple tactical nuances that when adopted can equal big results" says FDNY Chief Frank Leeb.


